About the Hygiene Project

In cooperation with **ExperTS** program which is funded by the **German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development** (BMZ), the **Indo-German Chamber of Commerce** (IGCC) is implementing the Hygiene Project to create awareness on the issue of Covid-19 infections in textile facilities and community.

The Textile Industry is an important sector in India being the second largest employer in the country. As textile manufacturers and producers are restarting their operations after the lockdown, the danger of Covid-19 is still prevalent. Textile workers are susceptible to contracting Covid-19 both in textile factories and in their community. The Indian Central and State governments have also put in place rules and regulations which textile manufacturers need to follow to prevent the spread of the virus.

The safety of workers and the workplace is central to sustainable business practices. With this in mind. The Hygiene Project seek to support textile manufacturers and producers in India to operate efficiently and safely through awareness program and training.

Activities in the Hygiene Project

Anti-Covid Hygiene Training

Provide free-of-cost **virtual** training to textile producers in India on mandatory and important hygiene measures required to maintain high hygiene standard in textile facilities to prevent the spread of Covid-19 infections.

Awareness Program

Create awareness regarding the danger of the spread of Covid-19 infections in textile facilities, communities in the vicinity, and to workers and their families members.

Create awareness on the importance of hygiene practices such as washing hands and social distancing, using a short 30-second video.

About Anti-Covid Hygiene Training for Textile Producers

- 1 Free-of-Cost virtual training
- Training curriculum is based on hygiene measures prescribed by the Indian government relevant to textile industries and following German hygiene standards,
- Training curriculum will be certified by the Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC).
 Upon completion, participants will receive a certificate endorsed by IGCC, ExperTS, and TSC.

- Training will increase participants' competitiveness and attractiveness in the international markets.
- Training materials will include **posters**, handouts, flyers, instructional video and other materials which participants will need to implement effective hygiene measures in their facilities,
- 6 Hand-holding support from hygiene experts in India during training and for implementation of hygiene measures in their facilities.
