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#### 1 Introduction

Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC) is an industry driven non-profit organization registered under Section 8 (1) of the Companies Act, 2013. TSC is a recognized as an Awarding Body by National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) since July 2022. Textile Sector Skill Council has been approved by National Skill Development Corporation, which is under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India. The Functioning of TSC is governed by its board with representatives from 14 Textile industry associations, Export Promotion Councils, DC Handloom and NSDC. TSC is committed to develop world-class skilled manpower for all segments of textile manufacturing, starting from Spinning to Fabric Finishing which includes organized mill sector, Power loom industry, Handlooms and technical textiles. TSC has 71 active Qualifications (Annexure-I) as on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 (which comprises more than 80% of the workforce in the sector) listing competencies of the respective job roles. TSC trained and certified 3.5+ candidates in the textile mill and handloom sector.

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is to invite organizations approved by NCVET as an Assessment Agency to be associated with TSC for conducting the Assessments for the candidates trained aligned to Qualifications owned by TSC. The RFP provides applicants with the relevant operational, application, and affiliation requirements that must be fulfilled for being eligible for being associated with TSC as an Assessment Agency.
